**AN ORDINANCE SETTING CHARGES FOR FEES,
RENTALS, LICENSES, AND PERMITS FOR THE
CITY OF BROWNWOOD; DESIGNATING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING PRIOR
ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BROWNWOOD, TEXAS, that**
